It all started in Butler County in 1970 and has grown throughout the Commonwealth to 23 separate Camps, including the Pennsylvania State Police Commissioners’ Honor Camp, conducted at the Pennsylvania State Police Academy in Hershey Pa. The State Police Butler Camp Cadet is accepting applications for the 2019 class. Camp Cadet is a week-long camp for boys and girls between the ages of 12-15 who have an interest in Law Enforcement. Troop D Camp Cadet has created one-of-a-kind programs to allow graduates of Phase 1 to remain active in the program. For graduates of the Camp Cadet program and/or youths over 15 years old, opportunities exist to participate in the Camp Cadet Leadership Development (CCLD) which was founded in 2013. For graduates of the CCLD program, opportunities exist to participate in the Phase 3, Principles in Practice (P.I.P.) program which was founded in 2015. Camp Cadet will create an opportunity to provide youth with a positive attitude toward the Law Enforcement profession, while building self confidence, self esteem, self discipline, self respect and respect for others.

Youth from **Butler, Beaver, Mercer and Lawrence Counties** can participate in the 2019 camp which will be held at Camp Lutheran in Prospect, PA from August 4th thru August 9th, 2019.

Youth can participate in the camp for only \$50. Family must participate in a mandatory fundraiser (selling 10 raffle tickets). Tickets will be distributed at orientation, and money and stubs will be collected upon arrival for drop-off at camp.
